1. **Conduct a waste, water, or energy audit with friends and a teacher**
 - a. Work with a school staff member to collect data.
 - b. Share your results with your principal.
 - c. Contact us to share your results and to learn how to create an action plan.
 - d. Create an action plan to make changes in your school.

2. **Friendly reminders, anyone?**
 - a. Create posters and signs around your school.
 - b. Add information about recycling and composting to your school website or newsletter.
 - c. Create a presentation or skit to air on your school's closed-circuit broadcast system.

3. **Start an environmental club**
 - a. Talk to your teacher, counselor or principal about starting an environmental club.
 - b. Take a field trip. Learn about what happens to your recycling when it leaves your school and your home.

4. **Join the discussion board**
 - a. Challenge another class or school to a friendly competition. See who can reduce their waste and increase their recycling!

5. **Celebrate your Success**
 - a. Write a press release.
 - b. Contact your school board.
